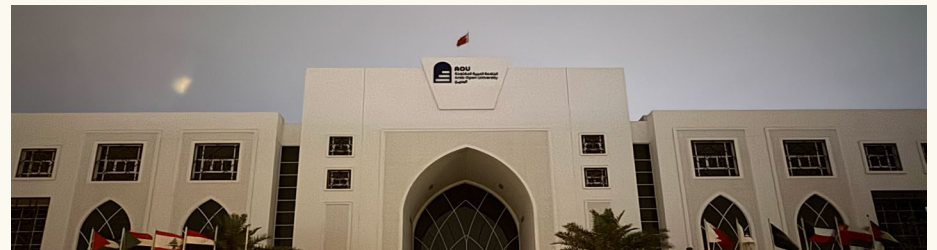
AOU Organizes a Microsoft Excel Training Course – Bahrain
