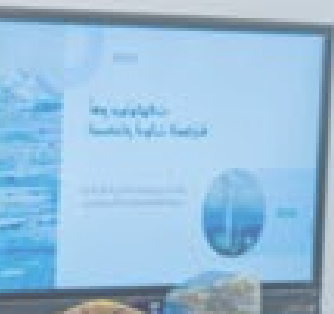

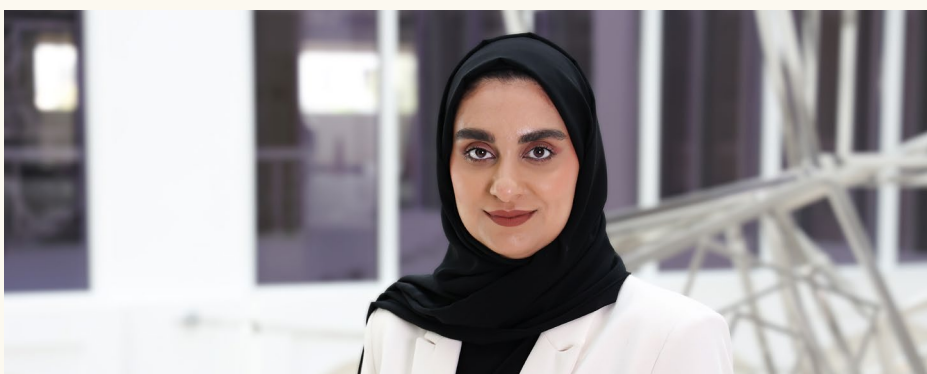


## Workshop on “Collecting and Analyzing Mixed Methods Research Data” – Oman

## AOU Signs Memorandum of Understanding with the Arab Institute for Training and Statistical Research – Lebanon

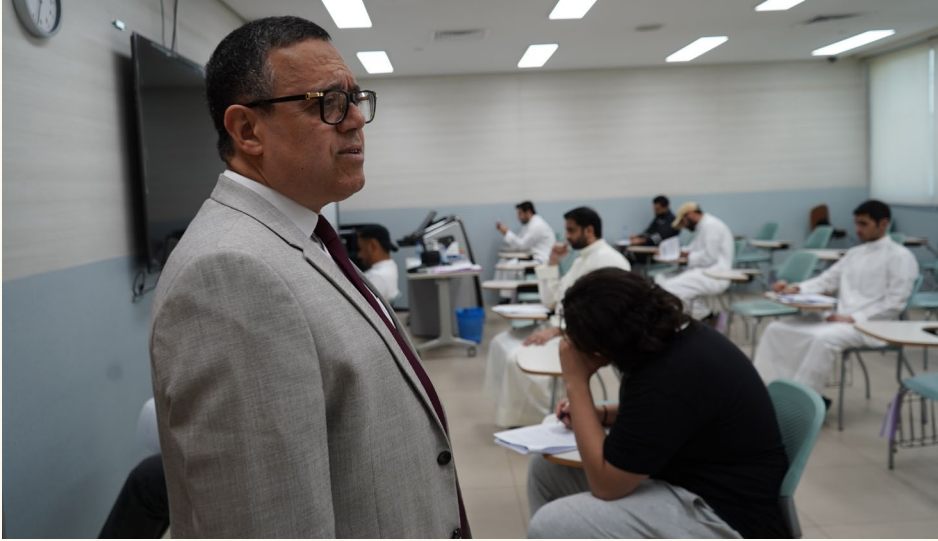
