Proposal Title: 7in7 - Enhancing Learners

Introduction:

- **Format:** Each session will consist of a slide prepared by the lecturer focusing on a specific soft skill.
- **Timing:** Sessions will take place during the middle seven weeks of the semester, excluding the first week and the last two weeks to avoid conflicts with the beginning and end of semester exams.
- **Delivery:** Tutors will prepare one slide each week to cover the key points of the designated soft skill.

- Coordination: Local Deans/PCs will arrange the topics with their tutors.
- Content: Topics covered will include but are not limited to:
 - · Creative thinking
 - Presentation skills
 - Emotional intelligence
 - Interview skills

- Negotiation skills
- Time management
- Teamwork and collaboration

Expected Outcomes:

Through the 7in7 initiative, we expect to achieve the following outcomes:

- Increased awareness and understanding of essential soft skills among Aouers.
- Improved ability to apply soft skills in academic, professional, and personal contexts.
- Enhanced Aouer engagement and satisfaction with their learning experience.
- Better preparation of Aouers for future career opportunities and challenges.
